

## **ATTENTION INDIANA DISABLED VETERANS & SURVIVING SPOUSES:**

### **PROPERTY TAX BENEFITS ARE CHANGING**

New legislation (HEA 1210) updates Indiana property tax deductions and introduces NEW credits for qualifying veterans with disabilities.

#### **★ NEW 100% PROPERTY TAX DEDUCTION**

For Totally Disabled Veterans & Surviving Spouses

You may qualify for a deduction equal to **100%** of your home's assessed value (*only applies to home + 1 acre*)

Eligibility:

- ✓ Must own or be purchasing the property
- ✓ Property must be your primary residence
- ✓ Must have lived in Indiana at least 1 year
- ✓ Served at least 90 days and was honorably discharged
- ✓ Must be classified as totally disabled

Application Deadline: January 15, 2027

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#### **🇺🇸 NEW \$250 PROPERTY TAX CREDIT**

For Veterans **Age 62+** with 10%+ Disability & Surviving Spouses

Eligibility:

- ✓ Must own or be purchasing the property
- ✓ Age 62 or older with at least 10% disability
- ✓ Served at least 90 days and were honorably discharged

Application Deadline: January 15, 2027

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#### **🇺🇸 NEW \$350 PROPERTY TAX CREDIT**

For Veterans with a Service-Connected Disability (10%+) & Surviving Spouses

Eligibility:

- ✓ Must own or be purchasing the property
- ✓ Service-connected disability of at least 10%
- ✓ Served during wartime and were honorably discharged

Application Deadline: January 15, 2027

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#### **!! BMV VOUCHERS**

- ✓ If you previously weren't qualified for the disabled veteran deduction because of assessed value, but instead, received a BMV excise voucher, please reapply. You may now be eligible for a credit.
- ✓ BMV excise vouchers will no longer be issued starting January 2027 with exception to those disabled wartime veterans that do not own property.
